CASE MANAGEMENT

LIVING IN ONE'S OWN HOME AS LONG AS POSSIBLE IS A STRONG DESIRE OF MANY SENIORS.

THAT'S WHAT CASE MANAGEMENT IS ALL ABOUT—HELPING PEOPLE REMAIN INDEPENDENT.

BY MATCHING A SENIOR'S NEEDS WITH COMMUNITY RESOURCES, COMMUNITY ACTION TEAM'S SENIOR AND RESPITE CASE MANAGERS HELP UNTANGLE COMPLICATED SITUATIONS AND FILL THE GAPS THAT THREATEN AN INDIVIDUAL'S INDEPENDENCE.

WITH THE RIGHT SUPPORTS IN PLACE, MANY SENIORS CAN REMAIN SAFE, SURROUNDED BY THE COMFORTS OF HOME.

CASE MANAGERS WORK WITH OLDER ADULTS TO:

- IDENTIFY CURRENT AND FUTURE NEEDS
- DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO PUT SERVICES IN PLACE THAT MEET THE IDENTIFIED NEEDS
- MAINTAIN ON-GOING CONTACT TO MAKE SURE NEEDS CONTINUE TO BE MET
- PROVIDE INFORMATION AND REFERRAL FOR COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR SENIORS
- CONDUCT COMMUNITY OUTREACH ACTIVITIES
- PROVIDE ACCESS TO IN-HOME SERVICES FOR HOMEBOUND INDIVIDUALS SUCH AS MEALS-ON-WHEELS AND RESPITE SERVICES.
